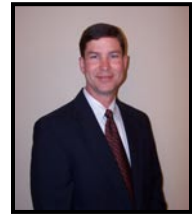

Mr. Pat "NAFOD" Haller joined National Security Cyberspace Institute in 2008 as an Operations Analyst supporting United States Strategic Command (USSTRATCOM). As a member of the C2 Development Division for Joint Force Component Command Global Strike/JF32 at Offutt AFB he currently is a member of the Functional Manager Office working on USSTRATCOM's only command & control Program of Record. In this capacity he works as a requirements engineer and operational test evaluator working with current operators to build collaborative tools and engineers to test the tools against established requirements. He is also the principle trainer for the division. He has over 20 years experience in theater airborne early warning, airborne command and control, and joint staff officer duties. He served as a Carrier Air Wing Mission Commander, Squadron Operations Officer, and the Battle Group Liaison Officer to the Combined Air Operations Center in Vicenza, Italy. Mr. Haller brings a abundance of operational command and control experience from Operations DESERT SHIELD, DESERT STORM, SOUTHERN WATCH, ALLIED FORCE, NOBLE ANVIL and ENDURING FREEDOM, and from Service and Joint exercises. He has flown 172 combat sorties, amassed over 4200 hours in Naval aircraft, and piloted 450 carrier landings aboard 9 different aircraft carriers. He has three years experience as Chief, Joint Experimentation, Future Capabilities Division, United States Strategic Command designing and executing wargames, limited objective experiments, seminars, and tabletop exercises to support Command and Control (C2), Intelligence Surveillance and Reconnaissance (ISR), Combating Weapon of Mass Destruction (CbtWMD), Space, Information Operations (IO), Integrated Missile Defense (IMD), Deterrence Operations, Network Operations, and Global Strike (GS).
